

PRAYER POINTS:

Trusting God's Leading:

Pray you will trust and follow God's leading, even when the path feels uncertain or uncomfortable.

Boldness in Evangelism:

Ask God to give you boldness and clarity in sharing the gospel, relying on His Spirit to guide your words.

Transformation Through God's Word:

Pray for a heart open to the transformative power of God's Word, becoming a true reflection of Christ's new creation.

Living in Repentance and Surrender:

Ask God to help you live a life marked by genuine repentance, surrender, and submission to His Lordship.

Immediate Obedience to God's Truth:

Pray for the courage to respond to God's truth with immediate obedience and a heart full of worship.

SCAN TO GIVE



· PERSONAL STUDY-

Divine Guidance: Philip obeys the Spirit's call to take the less-traveled road. **Something to think about:** When has God called you to take an unexpected or uncomfortable path? How did you respond?

The Gospel's Power to Break Barriers: The Ethiopian eunuch, a foreigner and likely an outsider, seeks understanding of Isaiah's prophecy.

Something to think about: How can you be intentional in sharing the gospel with those who might feel excluded?

Clarity Through God's Word: Philip explains Isaiah 53, revealing Jesus as the Messiah. Something to think about: How can you deepen your understanding of Scripture to share the gospel effectively?

Immediate Response to Truth: The eunuch's baptism illustrates the urgency of faith in action.

Something to think about: What steps can you take to act on God's truth in your life today?

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Getting to Know You:

1. What are some various ways that you indicate commitment to something or someone in your life?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read Acts 8:26, 29, 40 and Hebrews 11:8-16.

 Consider these passages and others that discuss living a life of faith. How do these passages reflect the difficulties in knowing whether you are hearing the voice of God or not? In what ways could their actions look like foolishness?
- 2. Read Acts 8:26-35, Isaiah 7:14, Isaiah 9:6-7, Isaiah 61:1, Isaiah 52:13 through Isaiah 53:12, Isaiah 55:6-7, and Isaiah 61:10. How might Philip have presented the Gospel of Jesus through the book of Isaiah? Considering that this was written 700 years before Christ came, how can we incorporate this passage in evangelism today?
- 3. Read Acts 8:36-38, Acts 2:37-38, Acts 16:25-33 and Romans 6:3-4. Why was it important to get baptized soon after salvation? What does baptism signify? What are the implications for waiting a long time or refusing baptism?

Taking it Home:

1. What role does Scripture play when you share the Gospel? How can you incorporate the Word of God more effectively in evangelism?
