#### **Getting to Know You:**

- 1. A popular plot in movies or television presents the protagonist with a supernatural ability to know the future. How would your daily life be transformed if you were granted that ability?
- 2. As you read the text in 2 Thessalonians 2:1-2, imagine yourself as one of the Thessalonian believers of that time; what would have been your biggest concern? Why do you think Paul felt compelled to address the confusion that had resulted from a false proclamation that the Day of the Lord had arrived?

#### **Digging Deeper**

- 1. Read 2 Timothy 4:2-4, Hebrews 13:8-9, 1 John 4:1, Matthew 7:22-23, Matthew 24:10-12 and Matthew 24:24, then discuss the danger of following winds of doctrine (Ephesians 4:14). While commentaries, Christian books or blogs, and Bible dictionaries are helpful, why is it essential that you know what the Bible says and haven't entirely delegated its interpretation to others?
- 2. How do you decide which doctrinal differences of opinion require debate or correction and when it is better to agree to disagree? Consider Titus 1:9 and Titus 3:9-11 along with 1 Timothy 4:6-8 and Matthew 7:6. How do you determine which issues are foundational to your faith and which are negotiable? See also John 3:16-18 and Acts 4:12.
- 3.2 Thessalonians 2:7 states that the Holy Spirit alone restrains the Antichrist and prevents widespread delusion and sin from overtaking the world. What can you then infer about the essential priority of a believer's intimacy with the Holy Spirit for sanctification; to discern truth, maintain purity, and mature in faith? (See Romans 8:5-10, John 14:16-17, 25 and 1 John 2:18-27)

## **Taking it Home:**

- 1. Why is the nature of apostasy, misinformation, and false teaching in our culture so enticing? What provocation or temptations divert a person from the truth? What steps are you taking to protect yourself from falling victim to the deception or being led astray by misinterpretation? (Ephesians 6:11)
- 2. Are you uneasy, confused, or frightened about end-time prophecies and the coming of the Day of the Lord? What would help alleviate your anxiety?

**Bible Story** 

Daniel Is Thrown Into a Den of Lions Daniel 6

**Key Question** 

What is the bravest thing you've ever done?

Use this guide to help your family learn how God can give us courage.

#### Activity

Word-Off

What You Need:

paper; pencils; timer

#### What You Do:

Grab a sheet of paper and a pencil for both you and your child. Invite your child to play a friendly "word-off."

Say, "We're going to have a wordoff. There are four rounds. For each round, I'll name a category. We'll both see how many words we can write down from that category in 30 seconds. Ready?"

#### Categories:

- Words that rhyme with fear
- Things that make us feel brave
- Things that roar
- ► Things we put trust in

At the end of each round, tally up the scores. At the end of the rounds, declare a word-off winner!

When you're finished, say, "Daniel dealt with all four of those categories in our story today. But in the end, he chose to put his fears aside, be brave, and trust in God."

#### Talk About the Bible Story

How was Daniel strong and brave? (He faced the lions in the lions' den.)

What's the bravest thing you've ever done?

Does having courage mean never being afraid? Why or why not?

Who are some people who can help you build up your courage?

Parent: Share a personal story about a time when a Bible verse you memorized helped you face a challenge or scary time.



## Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"Dear God, help us to remember that we are NEVER alone. You are with us at all times, and You will never leave us on our own. Give us the kind of courage that Daniel had when he chose to follow You. Help us to be strong and brave and to not lose hope when things get hard. You are a great and mighty God, and we know You can help us have courage. In Jesus' name, amen."

**Bottom Line** 

You can do what you should because God is with you.

#### Activity

**Getting Puzzled** 

#### What You Need:

five sheets of paper; marker; scissors; timer

#### What You Do:

On each sheet of paper, write one of the following letters: B, R, A, V, E. Then, cut up each sheet of paper irregularly (like a puzzle), keeping the pieces in separate piles. Invite your child to a challenge.

Say, "There are five puzzles for you to put together. I'm going to time you to see how long it takes you. Ready? Go!"

Press start on the timer. Cheer on your child as they put together the letters. Once they've got all the letters put together, ask them what word the puzzle spells ("BRAVE").

"That's right. Brave. We can be strong and brave because God is with us. That's something that Daniel did. He believed that God was with him, and he faced those lions with courage."

#### Talk About the Bible Story

How was Daniel strong and brave? (He faced the lions in the lions' den.)

What happened to Daniel in the lions' den? (The lions' mouths were shut. Daniel was safe because God was with him.)

Have you ever been in a tough situation and it felt like there was no way out? What happened?

What are some ways you can be strong and brave the next time you're in a similar situation? (Pray, read the Bible, recite Scripture you've memorized.)

Parent: Share a personal story about a time when a Bible verse you memorized helped you face a challenge or scary time.



#### Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, thank You for never leaving us. Even when times are tough or scary, You are always with us. Thank You for giving us Your Holy Spirit to help us get through each challenge. Please help us show others that they can be brave as they face their fears, too. Use us to be an encouragement to others and remind them that we can do what we should, because You are with us. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."
