## Getting to Know You:

1. How many generations of your family can you document? How are your family records kept, and who is your family historian?
2. In times of hardship, the placement of your faith becomes more evident. Describe a time when you relied on God and saw Him come through. What would you say to encourage someone going through a similar challenge?

## Digging Deeper:

1. Read Matthew 1:1-6 then identify the four women mentioned in the genealogy of Jesus. Discuss why listing them in the line of the Messiah would be a bit 'embarrassing.' Although the gospel writer did not need to mention any of these women in this genealogy, why do you think Matthew chose to include them? What makes each of these women unique?
2. Read Matthew 1:18-25 and discuss the precarious predicament God put Mary and Joseph in when she found out she became pregnant. In what ways might this tremendous blessing have felt like a curse? List and discuss other faith heroes who might have felt similarly about their own experiences.
3. Read 2 Kings 16:1-10 and Isaiah 7:1-16 to understand the context regarding God's prophecy of the virgin birth. God told Ahaz to ask for a sign. When is it appropriate to seek a sign from God? Ahaz said he wouldn't, yet how did he inappropriately test God? According to Isaiah 8:6-8, what would be the repercussions for Israel disobediently placing their trust in Assyria?

## Taking it home:

1. Do you ever feel your history or position makes you less qualified than other believers? How does the recognition of the women in Jesus' lineage encourage you?
2. Has your faith ever put you in a predicament with others? How did you react? If you had another chance, how might you respond better?
