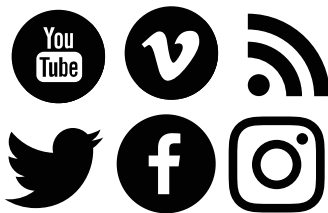

Getting to Know You:

1. Although none can fully explain the Trinity, what are some illustrations given by well-intentioned friends, pastors, or teachers to help describe the Trinitarian nature of God? What part has been helpful, and where do the analogies begin to fall apart?
2. Why is it essential that you comprehend the foundational essence of God? What potential consequences come from putting disproportionate emphasis on any one aspect of His character?

Digging Deeper:

1. As you read Mark 1:9-11, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, 2 Corinthians 13:14, and 1 Peter 1:2, note the presence of each individual in the Godhead. How do these scriptures help define and reinforce the doctrine of a triune God?
2. How do John 1:1-3, Romans 8:26-27, Colossians 2:9-10, John 1:14, and John 14:16-17 characterize the divinity and the functions of the individual persons of the Trinity? How would you summarize the role or the job description of each member of the Godhead?
3. How do Colossians 1:15-17, Romans 8:11, 1 Corinthians 8:6, John 6:38, and John 14:10-11 illustrate the diversity and yet the unity of the Godhead? How does the perfect relationship between the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit illuminate the practical purpose of submission and authority?

Taking it Home:

1. Whether ideologically intentional or by naive misunderstanding, have you ever ascribed to non-triune doctrines about God? What was the most relevant and compelling evidence about God's trinitarian nature you discovered this week? How will it affect your faith or change your manner of worship or prayer?
2. As we conclude this Answers series, summarize some foundational truths you and your family have gleaned from studying God's Word together. How will you ensure that your family will continue to prioritize knowing God's character and trusting His plans? How will you maintain a tangible example in your household?
