PRAYER POINTS:

**Start with What You Have**

Ask God to show you how to use your existing resources, time, and talents to serve others.

**Serve Where Needed**

Pray for a willing heart that says “yes” to whatever God asks, even when inconvenient.

**Courage to Sacrifice**

Pray that you would be bold and selfless when standing for Christ, no matter the cost.

**Stay the Course**

Ask God to help you remain faithful in your calling through every season of life.

**Marriage on Mission**

Pray that couples in the church would see their marriages as a tool for ministry and serve God in unity.

# PERSONAL STUDY

## Start with What You Have

Aquila and Priscilla opened their home and shared their skills to assist Paul (Acts 18:1-3).

***Something to think about:*** What skills, possessions, or influence do you already have that God might use for His purposes?

## Do What's Needed

They departed Corinth and contributed to planting the church in Ephesus, demonstrating flexibility and faithfulness (Acts 18:18-19).

***Something to think about:*** Are you willing to serve where needed, even if it is outside your comfort zone or veers from your original plan?

## Don't Underestimate the Power of Self-Sacrifice

They risked their lives for Paul and supported him during perilous times (Romans 16:3-5).

***Something to think about:*** In what ways might God be calling you to step out in sacrifice for the Gospel's sake?

## Be Faithful to the End

Eighteen years later, Paul still acknowledges Aquila and Priscilla as dedicated servants (2 Timothy 4:19).

***Something to think about:*** How can you remain faithful in using your gifts, even when recognition is scarce and the years feel long?

## Marriage on Mission

Aquila and Priscilla served together in unity, uplifting each other's roles in the church.

***Something to think about:*** If you're married, how can you purposefully align your relationship to serve God's kingdom together?

# LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



## Getting to Know You:

1. How did you come to Christ? What was it that convinced you Christianity was true?

## Digging Deeper:

1. Read Acts 17:16-17 and 2 Peter 2:6-8 about Paul and Lot, who both were provoked by the wickedness surrounding them. Study the life of Lot and the decisions he made in Genesis 13:1-13, Genesis 14:12, and Genesis 19:1 and Genesis 19:12-38. Where did he compromise, and what was the end result? According to 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 and 2 Timothy 4:6-8, how did Paul live differently, and what was his fruit? What can you take away from this?
2. Read Acts 17:16-34 and consider how different Paul's approach to witnessing was to Peter's in Acts 2:14-36. Why would Peter use Scripture and Paul use poets? Is it important to understand the background and beliefs of the lost when witnessing? Why? How would you tailor your message to an atheist as opposed to a non-observant Catholic?
3. Read Romans 1:18-23, Romans 2:12-16, Acts 17:24-30, and Acts 14:15-17 and discuss what people can know about God apart from the Scripture. For instance, what attributes of God can be seen in creation? What can we discern about God's moral law through our conscience? Then, consider what is revealed about God only through Scripture.

## Taking it Home:

1. Have you witnessed to anyone lately? How do you feel it went? What approach did you use? After this study, should you try a different approach?
