

- 2. What effect does worry have on you?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read Matthew 6:25-34. According to Matthew 6:27, 30, 32, Psalm 34:9-10, Isaiah 41:10, and 2 Timothy 1:7, why do we have nothing to worry about? What are the consequences of worry? Read Philippians 4:6-7 and Matthew 6:33. Discuss how we can practically respond to worry in our lives.
- 2. Why does the Bible talk about money so much? Read 1
 Timothy 6:6-10, Ecclesiastes 5:10, Ecclesiastes 7:12,
 Ecclesiastes 10:19 and Luke 12:16-21. Discuss how money
 can be a blessing vs. the root of all evil. How can abundance
 vs. scarcity affect our faith?
- 3. Read Matthew 6:33, Luke 17:20-21, Romans 14:17, and 2 Timothy 2:22. Discuss what it means to seek first the kingdom and his righteousness. How does this parallel Jesus' temptation in Matthew 4:1-4?

Taking it home:

- 1. Perhaps you've heard the phrase "let your faith be bigger than your fear." How can you make a conscious effort to turn your attention away from fears and toward promises when under attack this week? What are some key verses that you can use when you are worried?
- 2. How would your life look different tomorrow if you decided, in the power of the gospel, to seek first the kingdom of God? Take a moment and consider if you consistently put kingdom values above worldly values. If not, take a moment to repent.


