Getting to Know You:

1. When people meet you, how do they describe you? Does it differ from how you would describe yourself?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. In Matthew 16:13-16 Peter makes a declaration that Jesus is the Christ. Following this confession, read Matthew 16:17-18 and discuss what Jesus meant by "on this rock, I will build my church?" While Peter's name means 'the stone,' according to Peter in 1 Peter 2:4-10 and Jesus in Matthew 7:24-27, how should this statement be interpreted? What are the implications for those who trust and build their life on the 'living stone?'
- 2. Reflect on the significance of Peter's preeminence in opening the door of the kingdom—first with the Jews in Acts 2:14-17, then the Samaritans in Acts 8:14-17, and lastly the Gentiles in Acts 10:30-34,44-48. Then contrast Peter's actions with the actions that 'closed the door to the kingdom' by the Pharisees as seen in Matthew 23:13-15 and Luke 11:52. What then is meant in Matthew 16:18-19 by Peter having the keys to the kingdom?
 - Read Matthew 16:19 and compare it to Matthew 18:15-20 and 1 Corinthians 5:1-12. What is the meaning of "binding and loosing?" In examining the Scriptures on the keys and then on the "binding and loosing," would you consider this power to be exclusive to Peter or can it be applied to all believers? If we all have this authority, how should this be applied practically?

Taking it Home:

1. Consider your actions and your life. What are you building? Do your actions demonstrate that you are a 'living stone' and building a spiritual house or not? If not, take a moment to repent.
