#### **Getting to Know You:**

- 1. Which type of gamer are you? Do you prefer challenging puzzles and brainteasers or fast-paced action and reflex-testing games? What do you think your preference reveals about your personality? When the game gets complicated, are you motivated or discouraged by the score?
- 2. Did you ever swap love notes or exchange letters with someone deployed, away at college, or distant for some reason? With that in mind, what do you imagine about this exchange between Paul and the Thessalonian church, and why Paul sent Timothy for information?

#### **Digging Deeper:**

- 1. Read John 10:11-13, Romans 9:1-3, and 1 Thessalonians chapter 3, specifically focusing on verses 1-2, 5, 9-10. To what lengths were Jesus and Paul willing to go for the sheep and the lost?
- 2. Read 1 Thessalonians 3:3-5, 2 Timothy 3:12, and 2 Corinthians 1:8-9 as you consider the early believers' experience with persecution. What do you suppose would happen if America were to face the same intensity of persecution? What encouragement and hope do you find in John 15:18-21, 2 Corinthians 1:5-7, and Matthew 5:10-12?
- 3. Read 1 Thessalonians 3:6-13 and discuss the influence Paul's love for the Thessalonians and the believers' love for one another had on the church and, vice versa, on Paul. How does one grow in love? How does greater love beget greater holiness? Consider 1 John 4:16-20 and 1 John 5:3 in your answer.

#### **Taking it Home:**

- 1. Discuss one or two things your life group could do to better love the church body and the lost. What impact could your life group make in 6 months if you demonstrate this kind of love?
- 2. If persecution continues to increase in America, consider how you should personally respond. How will you prepare for when that time comes? How will you equip your family and loved ones for that eventuality? What will be your first step?

Activity

Egg-stra Challenge

What You Need:

Fork, egg, hand towel

What You Do:

Place the egg on a flat surface that it can't easily fall off of, such as a couch or coffee table. Give your child a fork and challenge them to scoop up the egg using only the fork—no other help—and then balance it for 5 seconds.

After several attempts, give your child the hand towel and let them use the towel to stop the egg from rolling away from the fork. This will still be challenging with the towel, but it will be possible.

Give them a few more tries. If they aren't successful, eventually let them use their other hand to scoop and belones

After the activity, ask, "What are situations that people go through that they need strength to push through? What helps people get through hard times?" Explain how the towel is like God. Say, "Just because we have God in our lives does not mean that we won't face hard things. Challenging times come for all of us. But God is always with us, giving us something to hold onto so we don't drop our egg, so to speak!"

#### Talk About the Bible Story

What helps you get through hard things?

What are some ways you are reminded that God is with you?

How did Joseph show grit in our story? (He trusted God even when bad things happened.)

How can Joseph's story encourage you?

How can you use your experiences to encourage others?

Parent: Share a kid-appropriate story about a time you faced something really difficult and were reminded that God was with you.



#### Bible Story

Joseph Sold by Brothers and Joseph in Jail Genesis 37, 39-40

**Key Question** 

What helps people get through hard things?

#### Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"Dear God, thank You for the story of Joseph, and what it teaches us about You. Help us to remember that we can hold on through hard things because You are with us. Help us to have grit, no matter what we are facing. Thank you for loving us, and for being with us always. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Rottom Line

Hold on because God is with you.

#### Activity

Hold On

What You Need:

Blindfold (bandana)

#### What You Do:

Blindfold your child and tell them to hold on to your shoulder (or hand). Then, lead them around the house without telling them where you're going. Bonus points if you can complete this activity outside—that would increase the mystery of the destination!

After you've spent a few minutes leading your child around the house (or outside), remove their blindfold and reveal their new location. If there's time, allow your child to lead you around too.

After the activity, say, "That was so much fun! You didn't know where I was leading you, but you knew I was taking you somewhere. Even though you didn't know where we'd end up, you had to trust me."

#### Talk About the Bible Story

In today's story, who had to choose to trust even though they didn't know where they'd end up? (Joseph)

What bad things happened to Joseph? (his brothers threw him in a well and sold him to a group of traders, he was put in jail for something he didn't do)

If you had been Joseph, would it be easy or difficult for you to trust God during these difficult circumstances? Why?

When is it difficult for you to hold on or to trust in God?

What can you do to remind yourself that you can hold on because God is with you?

Parent: Share a kid-appropriate story about a time you faced something really difficult and were reminded that God was with you.



#### Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, thank You for the example of Joseph—someone who showed grit by holding on and trusting You. I pray that our family would show that same kind of grit... that we would have big trust in our big God who loves us and wants what's best for us. When life feels difficult, help us to hold on and know that You are with us. Amen."
