Hunger for God's Word

Ask God to stir your heart to study and meditate on Scripture like the Bereans, seeking truth with eagerness and an open heart.

Boldness in Sharing the Gospel

Ask God to give you courage to speak about Jesus, even in opposition, following Paul's example of fearless proclamation.

A Heart That Loves the Lost

Ask God to fill you with compassion for those who don't yet know Him and equip you to reach out in love and truth.

A Spirit of Discernment

Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in understanding God's Word, help you recognize truth from deception, and apply His teachings wisely.

The Church to Be a Light

Ask God to strengthen His church so that it will be faithful, courageous, and committed to truth, turning the world right-side up for His glory

Persecution arose because of the truth being preached.

Something to think about: How do we respond when sharing our faith meets resistance?

Paul didn't just preach—he reasoned with people.

Something to think about: How does this challenge how we present the Gospel in a skeptical world?

Turning the World Upside-Down

The early church transformed culture through bold faith.

Something to think about: How can we impact our communities for Christ today?

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



Getting to Know You:

1. Share about a time when you tried to share a fact but those around you didn't believe you. How did you respond?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read Matthew 5:13, 43-48, Acts 17:1-6, Acts 19:11-27 and 1 Peter 4:3-4. What was meant and what was happening that caused people to say Christians were turning the world upside down? Describe what it would look like to see something like that happening in the Imperial Valley.
- 2. Read John 11:45-48, Acts 5:27-28, Acts 16:16-21, Acts 17:4-9, Acts 19:23-27. Discuss all the different groups and reasons people hated the Christian message. Why was their message such a threat? What reasons do people have for resisting the Gospel today?
- 3. Read Matthew 5:11-12, Acts 16:6-10, 2 Timothy 3:11-12 and 1 Peter 4:12-19. Why do you think God forbid Paul and his companions from going into Asia and then proceeded to send them into hostile territory? What should we understand about persecution and suffering? What are the implications if we are not being persecuted for our faith?

Taking it Home:

1. Does anyone in the group feel that they are being persecuted for following the Lord? Take some time to gather around and pray for that individual.
