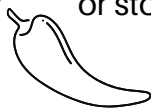

Getting to Know You:

1. When preparing to study a passage of Scripture, Hermeneutics recommends learning about the relevant history, the author, and the culture. With those parameters in mind, what do you know about the book of Matthew?
2. If you were writing a Gospel today, how would you describe modern America for future generations? How would your Gospel be written to adapt to this particular audience?

Digging Deeper:

1. Read Luke 5:27-32 and discuss how the author of Matthew came to Christ. The tax collectors of Jesus' day were considered Jewish traitors who collected money from their people for the Romans. Why do you think Jesus chose someone like Matthew? While not in recorded Scripture, most historians believe Matthew was martyred when he opposed the King's marriage to his niece. According to verse 28, what did the decision to follow Jesus cost Matthew?
2. Matthew wrote his Gospel to convince his audience that Jesus was the anticipated Messiah. Read Micah 5:2, Zechariah 9:9-13, Isaiah 53:4-6, and Isaiah 9:6-7 then describe the nature and work of the Messiah according to the Old Testament. Discuss why you think Jews failed to recognize Jesus as the promised Messiah. Consider Mark 3:1-6 as you answer.
3. What do you think it would have been like to experience Jesus in the flesh? According to John 16:5-6, 1 Corinthians 6:19, and Galatians 5:16, 22, why is it to our advantage that we are living after the resurrection of Christ?

Taking it Home:

1. Why do you follow the Lord, and what has it cost you?
2. In what ways have you experienced the Holy Spirit in your life? How might you encourage more of His work in your life?
