Getting to Know You:

- 1. What is the most challenging project you have ever completed? Why did you first decide on the task? What kept you motivated when things became complicated? How did you feel when the job was complete?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus' disciples and others of His time found it difficult to comprehend that Jesus was destined to go to the cross? Why do many still reject the Gospel when faced with suffering or hardship?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. What is the motivation and purpose for suffering according to 1 Peter 5:10, 2 Corinthians 4:17-18, James 1:2-4, 1 Peter 1:6-7, and Romans 5:3-5? How does Jesus' suffering on the cross achieve a comparable objective? (See Isaiah 53:5 and 1 Peter 2:24 for inspiration.)
- 2. Read Philippians 2:4-10, Hebrews 12:1-3, and 1 Peter 5:10. How does knowing that Jesus' suffering is inextricably bound to His glorification enable you to trust God's power and faithfulness when facing hardships or personal trials?
- 3. What hope and comfort does God offer a believer in John 16:33 and James 1:12? What encouragement do Philippians 1:29 and 2 Timothy 3:12 offer?

Taking it Home:

- 1. What is one enlightening thing you've learned this week that has helped you better comprehend and appreciate the significance of Jesus' suffering and victorious resurrection? How will you employ what you've learned to grow in your faith and when ministering to others?
- 2. Have you been guilty of taking the suffering Jesus underwent on your behalf for granted? How will you reflect on this week's study about Jesus the Suffering Servant to revitalize the appreciation of your salvation in the future?



Forgiveness is deciding that someone who has wronged you doesn't have to pay.

DAY 1

Read Psalm 86:5

Have you ever messed up really badly? Whatever the situation and whatever the mess up, there's good news. God doesn't choose to forgive some things and not others. God forgives all things.

Grab a piece of paper and draw a large heart in the center of the page. Write the words of this verse in puffy letters and then decorate your heart any way you choose. Put your heart next to your bed as a reminder this week that when you ask, God will forgive you.

DAY 2

Read 1 John 1:9

Jesus came to earth so that we can be forgiven. When you trust Jesus as your Savior, you become a part of God's family forever. Following Jesus doesn't make you perfect. You'll still mess up and need to ask God and others for forgiveness. Thankfully, when you ask, God will always forgive you.

To confess means that you admit when you're wrong. You let God know how you know you messed up. When you're honest with God, it helps you feel connected to God.
