

### **Getting to Know You:**

- Relate the story of when you received a gift you didn't understand at first, but once you knew its purpose and learned how it worked, you realized how useful it could be.
- 2. What has been the most surprising thing you discovered about the Holy Spirit from this sermon series? How will you utilize that information in your Spiritual growth?

### **Digging Deeper:**

- 1. Jesus said to wait for power in Luke 24:49 and Acts 1:8. Read Luke 22:54-62 and compare it with Acts 1:14, Acts 2:1-4 and Acts 4:29-31. What factors made the difference between the disciples' boldness and actions before and after receiving the Holy Spirit? Why did the disciples' time with Jesus not have the same impact as the indwelling of the Holy Spirit?
- 2. Read John 14:12-14, 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, and 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 and discuss how the Holy Spirit empowers a believer. What are the consequences of failing to live an empowered life? Consider 1 Corinthians 12:7 and Matthew 5:14-16 in your answer.
- 3. Read John 3:4-8, John 4:13-14 and 2 Corinthians 3:5-6, 17-18, and discuss the renewing work of the Holy Spirit. What does the Holy Spirit immediately transform? What changes are a matter of process? Read 2 Corinthians 5:17 and Romans 12:2 as you discuss.

### **Taking it Home**

- 1. What is your response to learning you have the power of the Holy Spirit? How will you step out in supernatural faith and obedience?
- 2. In what ways have you felt the renewing work of the Spirit in your life? How can you better exhibit the Holy Spirit's power in your life?
