


Getting to Know You:

- 1. Who was your favorite teacher or coach? How did that educator build your confidence or inspire you? In what way did those lessons influence your appreciation of the subject matter?
- Reflect on when you have felt the Holy Spirit's prompting or conviction. Share an example where you suppressed or ignored His voice and the resulting consequences.

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read John 16:7-11 and Titus 3:4-6 noting the role of the Holy Spirit in the redemption of the lost. Next, read John 3:18-19 and Romans 1:18 and discuss ways people commonly evade conviction or reject the truth. See also John 3:5-8, 2 Corinthians 4:4, and Ephesians 4:18-19. In addition to describing the Holy Spirit's burden in salvation, what do these passages infer about the limit of obligation given to the one sharing the gospel?
- Read John 14:26 and John 16:13-14 then discuss the Holy Spirit's purpose in a believer's life. Share examples of where you have experienced the Holy Spirit fulfilling His purpose in you.
- 3. Read John 14:15-17, Ephesians 1:13-14, and 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 then discuss other functions of the Spirit in a believer. What are some typical ways a believer might undervalue, underutilize, or even stifle the Holy Spirit's work?

Taking it Home:

- 1. How can you identify where you are limiting the Holy Spirit's influence in your life? What will you do to incline toward His instruction from this moment forward? What would help you hone in on His voice and tune out the world's noise?
- 2. How would relying on the Holy Spirit help ease stress and anxiety in your life? Read Romans 8:14-16 and Philippians 4:6-7 then pray to invite the Holy Spirit to be with you and trust His peace to comfort and protect you.
