### PRAYER POINTS:

### **Receive the Spirit Fully**

Ask God to fill you with the Holy Spirit and confirm His presence in your life in a fresh way.

## **Overcome Spiritual Dryness**

Pray that God would renew the joy of your salvation and rekindle your spiritual passion.

### **Be Empowered for Ministry**

Ask the Spirit to empower you to serve others, share the gospel, and move in spiritual gifts with confidence.

# **Stay Spiritually Sensitive**

Pray against spiritual callousness and ask God to keep your heart soft and responsive to His voice.

### Be a Vessel, Not a Container

Pray that the Spirit would not just live in you, but flow through you to impact others.

# The Proof of the Spirit - Acts 19:1-2

Paul discerned a missing element in the disciples he met: the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.

**Something to think about:** If someone looked at the fruit in your life, would they see the evidence of the Holy Spirit?

# The Purpose of the Spirit - Acts 19:3-6

The Spirit comes with power, not just for conversion, but for transformation and mission.

**Something to think about:** What's the difference between being saved and being Spirit-empowered in your daily walk?

# The Spirit is with You

Before salvation, the Holy Spirit convicts, draws, and bears witness of Christ.

**Something to think about:** Can you remember a time when the Spirit was drawing you before you even knew what it meant?

# The Spirit in the Believer

At salvation, the Spirit indwells and seals the believer, marking us as God's own.

**Something to think about:** How has your identity and purpose changed since you've come to faith?

### The Spirit upon the Believer

The empowering of the Holy Spirit is for boldness, witness, and supernatural ministry.

**Something to think about:** Have you experienced moments when you knew the Spirit was working through you?

# The Power of the Spirit - Acts 19:6-12

Through Paul, extraordinary miracles happened. But the focus is not Paul—it's the power of the Spirit.

**Something to think about:** Are you making space in your life for the Spirit to move in power?

# **Getting to Know You:**

1. Share about a time when something negatively affected you. How did you resolve it?

# **Digging Deeper:**

- 1. Read Acts 19:1-7 and discuss what the disciples lacked by not having the Holy Spirit. Read Ezekiel 36:26-27, John 16:6-14, Romans 7:21-25, 1 Corinthians 2:16, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Galatians 4:6-7, Galatians 5:17 and Ephesians 1:13-14. What changed for us when we became believers and what do we still struggle with? What role did the Spirit play in our salvation?
- 2. What is the difference between indwelling (Romans 8:9, 1 Corinthians 3:16), anointing (Exodus 28:41,1 Samuel 16:1,13 Luke 4:18-19), filling (Acts 4:31, Ephesians 5:18) and empowering of the Spirit (Luke 6:19, Luke 8:42-48, 1 Corinthians 4:19-20, Ephesians 3:14-21)? What does it look when you minister by the Spirit vs. ministering by your own abilities?
- 3. Read Proverbs 28:13, Luke 3:8, Luke 9:23-24, Acts 19:11-20, 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 and Galatians 5:19-22. Why do you think the Christians still had these pagan books? What did the Christians realize from the incident with the seven sons of Sceva that made them discard them? What is true repentance and what is the cost of following Jesus?

1. How have you experienced the Holy Spirit's work in your life? What steps can you take to be more receptive to His work in your life?
