# WALTER COLACE

#### PRAYER POINTS:

**Experience Regeneration** – Ask God to open your spiritual eyes and ears so you can see and hear as He does.

Walk in Justification – Pray that you would fully embrace your identity in Christ: forgiven and clothed in His righteousness.

**Live in Resurrection Power** – Ask God to stir up His power within you, enabling you to live victoriously over sin and fear.

**Break Spiritual Bondage** – Pray that the resurrection power would break every "slab" in your life—whether addiction, bitterness, or shame.

**Grow in Knowing Christ** – Pray for a deeper hunger to know Jesus relationally, not just intellectually.

# · PERSONAL STUDY-

#### The Reality of the Resurrection (Philippians 3:10)

The resurrection of Jesus is grounded in overwhelming biblical and historical evidence. **Something to think about:** How do the historical facts of Jesus' resurrection strengthen your personal faith?

#### The Power of Regeneration (1 Peter 1:3)

Through Jesus' resurrection, we are born again into a living hope.

**Something to think about:** In what ways have you seen spiritual transformation in your life or others since coming to Christ?

#### **Justification Through Resurrection (Romans 4:25)**

Jesus' resurrection confirms our pardon and declares us righteous before God.

**Something to think about:** How does knowing you are justified by Jesus' resurrection change how you approach God daily?

#### **Living in Resurrection Power (Romans 8:11)**

The same power that raised Jesus lives in believers and enables victorious living.

**Something to think about:** What areas of your life need the resurrection power of Christ right now?

#### **Knowing Christ Experientially (Philippians 3:10)**

Paul desired not just knowledge about Jesus but a deep, personal relationship.

**Something to think about:** Are you settling for knowledge about God, or are, you truly experiencing Him daily?

# LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS



#### Getting to Know you:

1. When considering whether a story is true, what factors help give credibility to the account?

#### **Digging Deeper:**

- 1. Read John 7:5, 1 Corinthians 4:9-13 and 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. Discuss the different accounts of the resurrection. Consider the different group accounts and the accounts of former unbelievers like that of James the brother of Jesus and the Apostle Paul. How do these different accounts and their willingness to suffer for Jesus provide a strong defense for the resurrection? What other evidence helps you to have confidence Jesus rose from the dead?
- 2. Read Romans 4:25, Romans 6:1-11, Ephesians 3:14-20, Philippians 3:7-11, and Philippians 4:11-13. In what ways does his death and resurrection still impact a Christian's life? According to these verses, how would you respond to a Christian who said they can't forgive or walk in freedom from sin? According to Romans 8:9-11 and 1 Corinthians 15:12-23, what does the literal resurrection of Christ guarantee for us as believers?
- 3. Read Genesis 4:1, John 10:11-15 and John 17:3. What does knowing mean in these Scriptures? What is the difference between knowing about and knowing experientially? Reflect on your discussion in question 2 and discuss what is meant in Philippians 3:10 when Paul says that we can know his resurrection power.

#### Taking it home:

1. Do you feel you have been living an empowered life through the Holy Spirit? If so, how? If not, why not?
