Getting to Know You:

1. What is your acquaintance with the Holy Spirit? What church teaching, personal experience, or Biblical study has formulated your understanding?
2. How did this week's lesson inspire or affect your opinion of the Holy Spirit, and what do you hope to gain from this series? Are you entering this series about the Holy Spirit with skepticism or hopeful anticipation?

Digging Deeper:

1. Jesus instructed His disciples to wait for the Holy Spirit before they began their ministries. (Luke 24:49) What does this infer about the importance of the Holy Spirit in your life and your calling to spread the Gospel?
2. Note the metaphors used to define the Holy Spirit as you read John 14:26, John 3:8, Romans 8:26, Ephesians 1:13, Matthew 3:16, 1 Corinthians 12:1-11, and John 7:37-39. Which of these depicts your personal experience with the Holy Spirit? Which, if any, evokes your suspicion or biases? About which Holy Spirit characterization are you most curious and why?
3. Read Acts 10:9-48, paying heed to the Holy Spirit's role in the narrative. What did the Holy Spirit say to Peter in verses 19-20, and what was his response? What did Peter learn about God, Jesus, the Jews, and the Gentiles? What does this reveal about the significance of the Holy Spirit in understanding Jesus' message and purpose?

Taking it Home:

1. Are you entering this series with resentment, skepticism, or bias due to previous ideologies? How will you set those aside and open your heart to what God wants to reveal to you about the Holy Spirit?
2. How will you implement what you have learned and employ the Holy Spirit (your helper and teacher) in your personal study this week?

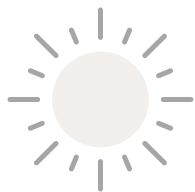
