Getting to Know You:

1. How would you define "tradition"? What family traditions do you still follow? Are there any traditions that you have cast aside? Why or why not?

Digging Deeper:

1. Read Matthew 15:1-9 and Matthew 23:16-28 and discuss how the Pharisees viewed tradition. Read 1 Corinthians 11:2, 2 Thessalonians 2:15 and 2 Thessalonians 3:6 and discuss the benefits of traditions. How can a good idea that starts in one man's mind develop into a tradition that can override Scripture? In today's culture, where do we focus on the external and not the internal, particularly in godly living? Lastly, what are some traditions in the church that are not commandments in the Bible?
2. Review Matthew 15:1-9. Then read Matthew 15:12, Luke 11:43-52 and Matthew 21:23-27 and discuss the inevitability of offense and confrontation and Jesus' response. Then read Matthew 22:34-40, Proverbs 26:4, Colossians 4:5-6, Luke 17:3, and Romans 12:19. Discuss where these passages lead us to respond biblically to confrontation. What can we learn from Jesus' model of not answering difficult questions directly?
3. Read Matthew 15:10-20 and Luke 11:38-44 and discuss the motives of the Pharisees and how they were so deceived. How could they pursue the law so fervently yet be so blinded? How do Romans 3:9-18, Ezekiel 36:26-27 and John 5:39-47 help us understand how religious people can miss a true connection with God? Read Acts 17:11-12 and John 8:12. How does the Bible direct us to avoid spiritual blindness?

Taking it Home:

1. Do you feel God is more interested in our hearts being right before God than in the way you worship? What will you do this week to align your heart with God?
2. Read Psalm 119:10-13 and discuss how you can discern what is a command of man and what is a true commandment.
