

Getting to Know You:

- 1. Describe one "superpower" skill or unique talent you have that most people are unaware you possess. Then, given the space and environment, demonstrate it for the group if possible.
- 2. Relate the story of when you have overcome particularly daunting circumstances, then describe the emotions you experienced with its victorious outcome. How might you share your salvation story using the same "come-from-behind-win" enthusiasm?

Digging Deeper

- 1. Read Luke 5:17-26, observing what the men endured to bring the paralyzed man to Jesus. How would you describe the men's character and determination? Name a few things you could accomplish if you utilized the same tenacious spirit for the lost. What has been holding you back?
- 2. Some believers state they feel inadequate when sharing their faith. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-2:5 and 2 Corinthians 3:4-5 outlining the contrast between your human nature and your extraordinary power source and His sufficiency in meeting your needs. How do these passages help give you the confidence to share the Gospel?
- 3. Have you ever felt like a failure when someone didn't respond to the gospel invitation? What are some obstacles to salvation described in 1 Corinthians 1:18-24, 2 Corinthians 4:4, and Matthew 13:18-23? How will you implement these words to prevent discouragement when you share the Gospel in the future?

Taking it Home

- 1. Relate the circumstances of a recent time when you gave a Gospel invitation. What did you say, and how was it received? What would you change about your presentation if you could do it over again?
- 2. What 'inadequacies' do you feel you must overcome to present the Gospel better? Which are practical things you can improve, and which are merely emotions? What steps will you take to become better qualified and feel more confident to share your faith?


