Getting to Know You:

- 1. Who is the most famous person you have ever met? Describe the situation and any credentials that were required to have access to them. How confident are you that you could easily approach him or her again?
- 2. What initially convinced you of God's existence? How would you include that evidence in your testimony and when sharing the gospel with an unbeliever? What challenges do you anticipate in response, and how would you reply?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Compare Judges 17:6 with Romans 1:18-23 and Romans 2:12-16. Based on these passages, what is the purpose of your conscience? What are its limitations as a guide to truth? Why is God's Word a more reliable source for knowing right from wrong? (Psalm 119:160)
- 2. What responsibility does 1 Peter 3:15 place on a follower of Christ? Why is it essential according to 2 Timothy 4:3-4 and John 17:3? Where do Psalm 19:7, Romans 10:17, and James 1:21 suggest you should turn if you want to develop your apologetic skills?
- Have you ever felt inadequate or ineffectual in explaining or defending your faith in God? What encouragement can you draw from 1 Corinthians 2:1-5, Jeremiah 9:23-24 and Isaiah 55:11?

Taking it home:

- 1. Have you ever made a decision based on emotions or what felt right? (Proverbs 19:21) What will you do next time you are tempted to follow your heart?
- 2. How does the assurance of God's existence motivate you to trust Him more? How will you communicate that same confidence to a friend battling doubt?


