PRAYER POINTS:

Lead with Integrity – Ask God to help you examine your heart and lead others by example in humility and truth.

Value the Church – Pray that you would treat the church with the reverence and care it deserves as the body Christ died for.

Guard Against Deception – Pray for discernment to recognize and resist false teachings and spiritual attacks.

Feed the Flock – Pray that God would use you to teach and encourage others through His Word, offering solid food not just milk.

Live for Eternity – Ask God to shift your focus from temporary comforts to eternal priorities and kingdom values.



· PERSONAL STUDY-

The Roster of Shepherds - God chooses and uses faithful shepherds.

Something to think about: When was the last time you got alone with God to hear His voice and prepare for His calling?

Shepherds Lead - Leading starts with your walk **Something to think about**: Are you tending to your own heart before trying to lead others? Who has God placed in your flock?

Shepherds Care – Shepherds love and serve the church that God bought with His blood **Something to think about:** Do you value and treat the Church as precious to Christ? How does that affect your service?

Shepherds Guard – Wolves will come from outside and within **Something to think about:** Would you recognize false teaching if it showed up in your feed, church, or friend group?

Shepherds Feed - Nourishing others with the whole counsel of God

Something to think about: Are you feeding others spiritually or just entertaining them? Are you growing in the Word yourself?

Digging Deeper

- 1. Read Proverbs 4:23, Acts 20:28, and 1 Timothy 4:16. Why is it essential for leaders to emphasize self-watch before flock-watch? Read Exodus 18:24-26, 1 Samuel 16:1, John 15:16, Ephesians 4:11-13, and Titus 1:5. What is the significance that God and other leaders appoint leaders? In what ways can it be said we are all called to leadership?
- 2. Read Ezekiel 34:1-10, Matthew 7:15-19, Acts 8:9-24, Acts 20:28-30 and 2 Peter 2:1-3. Discuss the internal and external threats to the church in these passages. How can we recognize the "wolves" and protect ourselves? What are some dangerous teachings floating around today?
- 3. Read Acts 20:31-38, 1 Corinthians 9:19-27, and Colossians 1:9. What are some characteristics of Paul that make him such an effective leader? Contrast the character of Paul with that of the false teachers. What can believers do to grow in godly character?
