## 1.) **READ** Luke 20:1-18 aloud together.

## 2.) **DISCUSS** the following:

- Share your thoughts on **authority**: In what ways are you thankful for the authorities that you have experienced? What are some of the big questions/challenges with authorities that you have noticed?
- Jesus was "Gospeling" or "Good News-ing" in the temple while the religious leaders were "Guarding". Luke typically uses Gospel as a verb rather than a noun. What are some of the actions words that would be associated most with your life? What are the typical reasons those words would be most common for you?
- What stands out to you about the owner's **patience** with the tenants?
- In what ways do you find yourselves, like the tenants, thinking of yourself as the owner of your life rather than a **steward** of the time God has given you on this earth?
- What would it look like for Jesus to be more of the **cornerstone** in your life this week? In what ways do you struggle with Jesus being the cornerstone of your life?

3.) **PRAY** together. Ask the Lord to help you apply His word to your life.
