



This morning we begin a new series based on the book of Proverbs, focusing on what it truly means to pursue wisdom in a world overflowing with information but often lacking clarity. Proverbs invites us beyond quick fixes and easy answers into a deeper relationship with God, reminding us that “the fear of the Lord is the foundation of wisdom” and that true understanding begins not with knowing more, but with knowing Him.
