

**His Clear Communication**  
**Jesus: The Dynamic Leader – Part 5**  
**Luke 6:17-49**

The ability to communicate clearly is crucial for effective leadership. A good leader doesn't necessarily have to be a dynamic speaker, but the leader must possess the capacity to transmit information and inspiration to those who follow.
