In the NT, the phrase "pure in heart" has the idea of 3 concepts:

Psalm 24:1-4
"Pure heart" (Hebrew)
¬¬¬ - {bar}
1) pure, clear, sincere
2) clean, empty

Psalm 51:10

יוֹחֹטָ tahowr {taw-hore'}-pure to be bright; that is, (by implication) to be pure (physically sound, clear, unadulterated; Levitically uncontaminated; morally innocent or holy): —be (make, make self, pronounce) clean, cleanse (self), purge, purify (-ier, self).
