Types of Mercy

1. God's Mercy towards us, God's grace towards us

GRACE - God's Riches At Christ's Expense

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3:16

16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Ephesians 2:4-5
"As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, 4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions it is by grace you have been saved."

2. Mercy we give to others

7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 8 The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

Philippians 2:5-8

5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus... being made in human likeness - he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death even death on a cross!

Luke 10:25-37 - The Good Samaritan 25 And a lawyer stood up and put Him to the test, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" Who do you need to show mercy to today? Who do you need to ask forgiveness from today? Who do you need for forgive today? **MERCY vs. GRACE** The difference between mercy & grace... Mercy is not getting what we deserve... Grace is getting what we don't deserve... Psalm 103 says "He redeemed my life from the pit" - that's mercy "Crowns me with lovingkindness and compassion – that's grace! We've been rescued (from hell), but need to continue in God's grace... If God has done this for you and me, how can we not do that for others...giving of grace... Blessed are those who are merciful... **Bucket vs. Funnel** What does a bucket do - it collects... What does a funnel do - it gives out Oh, we want God's mercy on our lives, but are you a reservoir or a conduit?? God, I need your help...I want to forgive, release from what they did Are there circumstances, people, in your life you haven't let go?
