In April 2023, the Ovcharenko family began their new life in the U.S. after fleeing the war in their home country of Ukraine. Over the past year, Andrii, Oksana, and Ruvym have settled into daily life in Morgantown. Andrii currently works for Lytle Construction Company, Oksana is employed by the Suncrest Early Learning Center, and Ruvym is thriving as a second grader at North Elementary School.

The family has begun the process of making Morgantown their permanent home and is working with an immigration attorney to apply for asylum in the U.S.

Fint-Clark Named Buswell Award Winner



Rebecca "Becca" Fint-Clark has spent much of her life involved in community and civic engagement. She grew up in West Virginia's 4-H program, and that experience helped shape the person she is today, igniting a passion to continue a life of service.

In recognition of her outstanding accomplishments, Fint-Clark received the Mary Catherine Buswell Award on April 24 from the WVU Council for Gender Equity.

Fint-Clark has served as a WVU Extension 4-H agent and associate professor in Monongalia County for more than 16 years. In this role she has helped thousands of youth, including girls and young women, gain valuable experiences and build a strong foundation for future success.

Fint-Clark received a grant from the Women's Giving Circle of North Central West Virginia in 2021 where she led The Girls Group. This initiative focused on empowerment through journaling, mindfulness and interactive activities. Becca expanded these efforts into a virtual group during the pandemic for those who were isolated and wanted continued support.

Each year, the county hosts more than 350 youth at 4-H camp. Fint-Clark's work to secure \$6,000 in scholarship funds annually has enabled low-income and underserved youth to attend a camp and benefit from this unique experience. She is committed to making the camp experience safe and fun for participants, but also places a strong emphasis on education. She works with the local

community, as well as WVU, to identify speakers and mentors who bring vast perspectives and experiences to these events.

Fint-Clark and her team have developed strong partnerships in the community. She and her team regularly visit local schools to provide educational programs on a host of topics, including STEM and nutrition. You can also regularly see Fint-Clark and her team in the community where they highlight service and civic engagement for youth. Whether youth are participating in a local fair, visiting a senior living center or sorting food, Fint-Clark shares her passion for giving back to the community and commitment to "making the best better."

In addition to her work with local youth, Fint-Clark also works with volunteers for WVU Extension including Community Educational Outreach Service clubs, 4-H volunteers and others who support activities. Under her mentorship and leadership, she helps ensure that all Monongalia County residents can engage with Extension programs.

Fint-Clark's late mother, Stacy, instilled in her a strong work ethic and a passion for empowering women. Becca is an active member in the WVU Women's Leadership Initiative where supports fostering she positive professional relationships and development. She mentors young women by identifying scholarship opportunities, internships and career placement that will help them achieve their fullest potential. Outside of her work with Extension, she is actively involved in identifying opportunities for her daughter and other young women to learn and discover.

As one of her nominator's noted, "Becca goes above and beyond to ensure that youth are provided with valuable resources to help them grow into positive, service-minded young adults and adults."



The family is being sponsored by Harner Chapel UMC. Unfortunately, the benefits that were offered to Andrii and Oksana when they arrived, such as SNAP and Medicaid, are no longer offered by the US government to Ukrainian war refugees.

Because it will be 2 to 3 months before Alex and Natalia can receive their work permits, we are gratefully accepting gift cards in the church office and in the offering plate. Gift cards to Walmart and Kroger would be especially helpful at this time. In addition the Mission Team has designated the April loose change offering to Alex, Natalia, and their family by way of Harner Chapel United Methodist Church.

Thank you to everyone who has offered support and welcomed Andrii, Oksana, and Ruvym to our community over the past year. Now we have the opportunity to support a new Ovcharenko family as they settle in to life in Morgantown.


PRAYER QUILT MINISTRY
