








Girl Scout Cookies Sale Today!



What is an Acolyte? An acolyte is a child or youth who assists in the worship service. The acolyte will light candles on the communion or altar table, help with distributing and collecting the offering plates, and serving communion.

The acolytes will extinguish the candles at the end of the service and carry the light out into the world as a sign that Jesus Christ is for all people everywhere, and that Christ goes with his people into the world where they serve as his living body.

March Health Awareness: Colorectal Cancer

Colorectal Cancer is the second leading cause of cancer-related deaths worldwide.

What is Colorectal Cancer?

Colorectal cancer is also called colon cancer. Colon cancer occurs when there is abnormal growth of cells in the colon. These abnormal growths are called polyps. Over a period of time, polyps can turn into cancer.

Symptoms of Colorectal Cancer:


- Change in bowel habits
- Blood in or on your stool
- Diarrhea or constipation
- A diet high in processed meats
- Feeling of the bowel not fully emptying
- Abdominal aches, pain, or cramps that are constant and consistent
- Unexplained weight loss

Reducing the Risk of Colorectal Cancer:

- Getting screened routinely, beginning at age 45
- A diet high in whole grains, fruits, and vegetables and low in animal fats
- Increasing exercise and maintaining a healthy weight
- Restricting alcohol consumption and tobacco use



The gathering will offer a space for learning, worship, prayer, and communion, followed by informal conversations and refreshments.


