The Church Council recently approved the 2024 general operating budget for Suncrest United Methodist Church (this does not include the Trustees account, which oversees the general upgrades and maintenance of the church buildings and related facilities, or the budget for the Early Learning Facility). support, room rentals, and a one-time transfer from the employee retention credit reserves that the church received during the pandemic.

There are so many positives that our church is currently experiencing – growing attendance, spirited participation, and expanding youth programs. We felt it was important not to reduce our investment in the

You will note that we will be operating under a deficit budget, but we are hopeful this will be offset as the year progresses.

The income that supports the general operating budget comes from several sources, but primarily from the tithes and offerings of the congregation. Other income originates from the Trustees to support the housing allowance provided to our senior pastor and administrative programs and personnel that supports these changes; thus, the recommendation and approval to use a one-time transfer from the ERC reserves.

Clearly, to continue to support our church at the current level, or to expand in the future, we need to grow financial support from the the membership. The projected income is based upon the actual contributions made in 2023, so as we look forward to this new year, we are hopeful that the many, many positives that we are experiencing will be favorably supported.

Should you like to review a more detailed budget, it is available at the church office. We also welcome any questions that you may have.

Good things are happening at Suncrest United Methodist Church. Pastor Larry and the church staff and many volunteers have us pointed in an exciting direction. It is up to us as members to support this growth.



April Is Stress Awareness and Move More Month

Stress is a feeling of worry or mental tension caused by difficult circumstances. Stress is a normal human response. However, uncontrolled stress can cause other health issues. Research shows those who experience chronic stress are at a higher risk of heart disease and stroke.

Stress can also lead to unhealthy behaviors, such as:


- Unhealthy eating habits
- Smoking
- Inactivity
- Failing to take medications as prescribed

Stress Busters to Focus on Your Physical and Mental Health

- Take a walk. Get outside and out of the house. Be present and enjoy the sights and sounds around you.
- Create a regular bedtime and wake-up routine. This will help to make sure you're getting adequate sleep every night. Limit the use of electronic devices before bed.

- Connect with the people around you. Reach out to friends and family.
- Focus on your present experiences without interpretation or judgment. This is called **mindfulness**.
- Spend time with your pets. Pets are shown to sometimes help reduce physiological reactions to stress.
- Work out: This can include 150 minutes of moderate exercise or 75 minutes of vigorous activity or a mixture of both per week. Exercise is shown to relieve depression, anxiety, and tension.
