Pat discussed some practical ways of following Jesus and his example of serving. Name the 4 things that were mentioned.

Of the 4 things, which one comes naturally to you? Which is most difficult?

In thinking about Brother Lawrence, what is one way you can serve others through your "ordinary work?"

Name one way you could serve someone else this coming week.
