What is a kingdom?

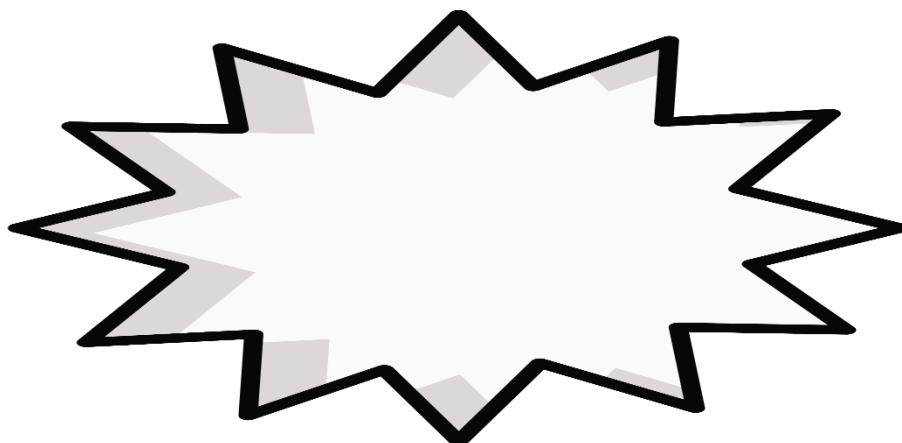
It's a place a King or Queen rules over. We have a Queen who rules over our country.

If you were King or Queen for a day, what choices would you make? What rules would you make? Write them in the starburst

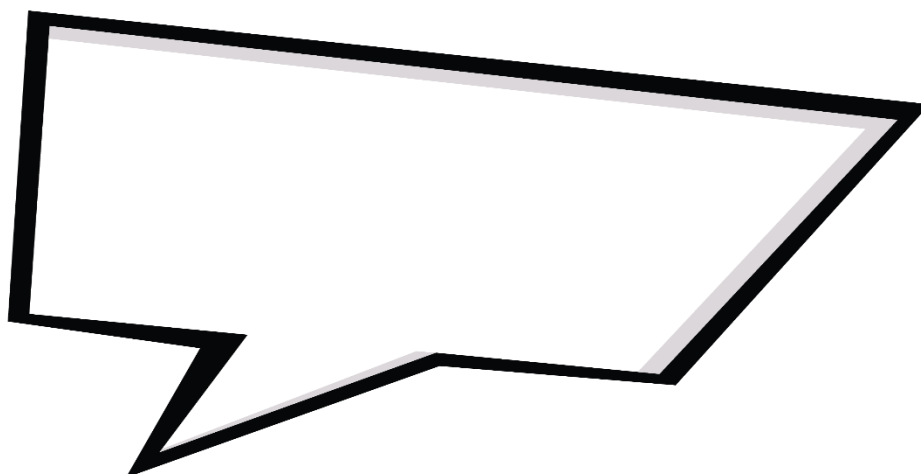

Ready: God's Kingdom

God wants His Kingdom to be in the heart of every person on the earth. Our choices should be His choices. Our words should be His words. His Kingdom on earth should look like His Kingdom in heaven. That means that deciding who is in charge of our lives is important.

If you have already prayed for Jesus to be king of your life, then you are a Christian and that means He makes the choices, and you follow what He wants you to do.

That's fantastic!! He loves you and His instructions for us are to only do us good and live our life the best way we can for Him



When Jesus rules our hearts, our minds, and our actions then we will be different. It's like having a new body that does things a different way. We now only want to do what God wants and what is good for us. We call it "being born again". That does not mean you go back into your Mum and get born as a baby! No more nappies and mashed up food for you!

Your spirit is what is reborn. **You are a new creation.** You have been crafted into a new person!!

2 Corinthians 5: 17 says

*anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person.
The old life is gone; a new life has begun!*



You are given a new heart inside. Not a real heart like in an operation but a heart that cares for people like God does, that wants to do what He wants and that is kind and thoughtful and puts other people before yourself.

God has a better way for us to live:

Close to Him and where we always want to do things, He has planned for us to do.

Let's pray together now and ask Jesus to be in charge of our hearts, minds, and actions:



Jesus, thank you that you love me and have fantastic plans for my life. Please be in charge of my choices and what I do. I want to make you the most important part of my life. Please make me more like you. Amen

Now ask Him this question: Jesus, please show me how much you love me? Please show me what my life looks like with you being number 1. Then sit and listen for about 30 seconds. What did He tell you?
