TITLES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Even as there are numerous names and titles of the Father and the Son in Scripture, so there are of the Holy Spirit. These titles set forth different aspects of the Spirit's character, functions or ministrations. Most of these titles refer to some specific work or operation that the Holy Spirit desires to perform in the hearts and lives of the people of God.

Titles of His Deity

This group of titles sets forth the deity of the Holy Spirit and shows His distinction from and association with the Father and Son. A number of them set forth the Spirit as representing either the Father or the Son, but all show His divinity.

It is the Holy Spirit who brings to us the wisdom, faith and power of God Almighty. All that is in God is brought to us by the Holy Spirit. He is to us all that we need.
