
"'Well done, my good servant!' his master replied. 'Because you have been **trustworthy** in a very small matter, take charge of ten cities.'


Luke 16:10-12


Given that trust develops as we show ourselves to be trustworthy, discuss what specific behaviours and attitudes tend to build trust between us and why.
