Our lives are like a fruit tree. If we live our lives God's way, the Bible says we grow strong like a tree by a river.

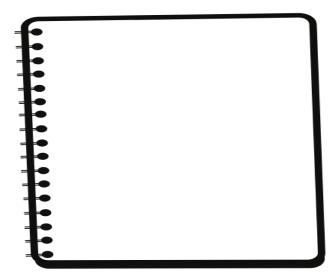


Look up Psalm 1: 1-3 and Ephesians 3: 16-17 in your Bible.

When you look at an apple tree you know it's an apple tree because of the fruit that it has on it. We are like a fruit tree. Our fruit is the attitudes and behaviours we show and do that reveal what is in our heart.



We need to show **kindness** to others, to do **good** things for our friends as well as our enemies, to show **love** to everyone and bring **peace** into every situation we face. Other people notice what we do and how we behave.



As Christians with the Holy Spirit showing us what to do, we can show people a different way to live: how to be calm and peaceful when others would get angry, to love people no one else wants to love etc

Think of something that you could do right now to show someone that you have "good fruit" in your life.

- You could do a kind thing for someone such as washing up, tidying something or helping them
- You could obey your parents the first time they ask you to do something (though you should do this anyway!!)
- You could be calm instead of getting angry at a situation that frustrates you
- You could not take an extra biscuit or snack when you want one or choose to wait for something that you really want to have.



Let's chat to God about the fruits of the Spirit

- 1. Ask God which fruit He sees in your life already
- 2. Tell God your favourite fruit to eat
- 3. Ask God to show you one fruit of the Spirit He would like you to show more of today/this week.
- 4. Ask God to show you what He would like you to do to show someone that that fruit/attitude is in your heart

Or you could use this prayer to help you:

Thank you, Jesus, that you love me and have given me the Holy Spirit to guide my life. Holy Spirit will you please help me every day to live my life like Jesus did. Please help me to be kind, loving, peaceful, joyful, patient, good, faithful, gentle, and self-controlled. Amen
