This verse tells us to go into all the world and preach the Good News.



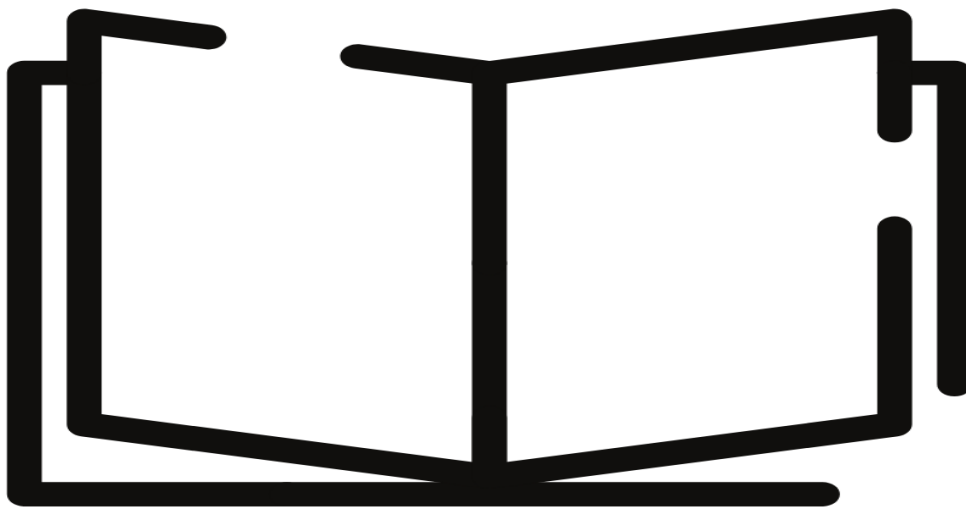
But what is Good News? Is it from a newspaper? No! Is it from the tv? No! Is it something just grown-ups talk about? No!

What is your Good News to share? What is your story?*

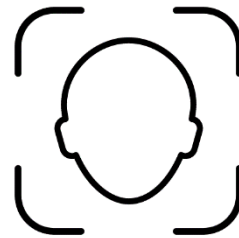
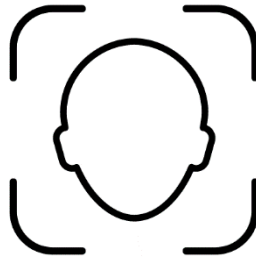
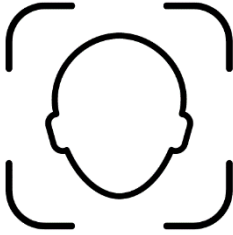




Now think of all the places you go. Write or draw them in the footprints below. Remember all the clubs you go to, church, school, friends you meet.

If God is sending us, then He will also give us everything we need to help us. He gives us the Holy Spirit to help us know what to say and who to speak to.



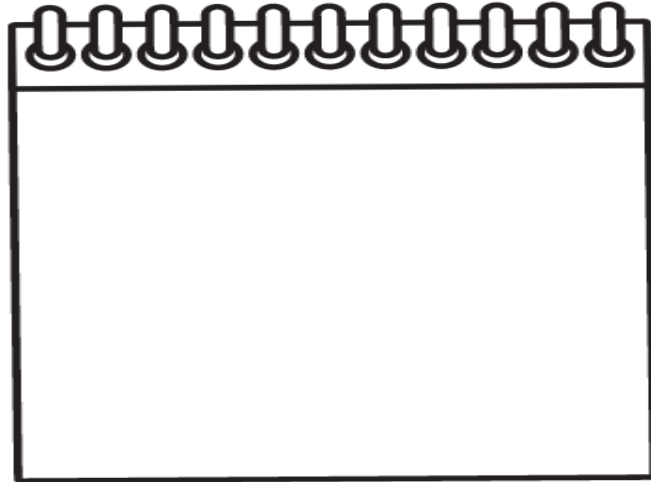
Read **Acts 1: 8**



In **Luke 10: 1-9** we read how Jesus sent 72 disciples (disciple means follower or learner) in pairs and gave them some instructions.



What did Jesus tell them to do?



Today God is sending you to go and share the good news that Jesus died to give us freedom from sin and sickness and to show God's love to everyone we meet!



Let's chat to God about changing the world so more people can be His friend and know His love:

1. Tell God about a time you remember when He helped you.
2. Ask your grown up to tell you a time when God did something good for them
3. Chat to God about all the places you go each week and thank Him that He goes to all those places with you
4. Ask God who He wants you to share your story, your good news, with this week in one of the places you go.
5. Thank Him that that He will give you the words to say and He will make you brave.
6. Then Go and do it!!



Or you could use this prayer to help you:

Thank you, Jesus, that you loved the world so much that you came to die for us, to wash away our sin and bad choices and make us clean so we can be close to You and have You live in us. Please help me to love others just like You do. Today I pray for (say the name of one of the people you drew in the faces on the previous page) to know You. Please help me know what to say and do to show them that You love them and want to be close to them like You are close to me. Amen
