Jesus even prayed that we would have heaven on earth!



they should have? Take a minute to write down anyone you know who needs heaven on earth today and what they need praying for.





Let's chat to God about heaven:

- 1. Ask Him the best thing about heaven
- 2. Ask Him what it looks like, what it smells like, what it sounds like.
- 3. Ask Him to show you what bit of heaven He wants you to bring to earth today.
- 4. Chat to Him about
 - Someone who needs to know healing because in heaven everyone is well
 - Someone who is lonely and needs to know joy like there is in heaven
 - Someone who is sad and needs to know love like there is in heaven
 - Someone who is worried and needs peace like there is in heaven
 - Someone who needs something for their family or their home because God has so much of everything we need in heaven



Or you could use this prayer to help you:

Jesus, I thank you that you love me so much. Thank you for having good plans for my life with you. Please help me to live every day of my life the way you want me to. Thank you that you want everyone to have all the things on earth that are in heaven. Today I pray for (say your family/friends' name here) and ask that you would change things for them so they can know heaven on earth in their life. (Now pray specifically for what you want God to do for them). Thank you that your Words are true, and you are faithful to all your promises. Amen
