News Travels Quickly Exodus 18:1-12

Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, brings Zipporah, Moses' wife, and their two sons Gershom and Eliezer to be re-united with Moses and the Israelites in the Desert. Jethro is very interested in hearing the account of the Exodus, directly from his son-in-law, Moses. Upon hearing Moses' personal testimony, Jethro is amazed at how Yahweh dealt with the Egyptians (a world superpower at that time) and he comes to believe that Yahweh is greater than all other gods (like those found in Egypt).

- 3. When given the opportunity to share his testimony, what did Moses do?
- 4. What didn't Moses do?
