 - a. I am a Fellow Elder
 - a. I Witnessed Christ's Suffering
 - b. I Will Partake in Glory with You
- 2. Shepherd the Flock Among You (Peter's Plea) vs. 2-3
 - a. Do:
 - i. Exercise Oversight
 - ii. So Willingly as God Would Have You
 - iii. So Eagerly
 - iv. Be an Example to the Flock
 - b. Do Not:
 - i. Act Under Compulsion
 - ii. Act For Shameful Gain
 - iii. Be Domineering
- 3. When the Chief Shepherd Appears (A Promise) vs. 4, Hebrews 13:20
 - a. Unfading Crown of Glory
- 4. Peter exhorts the Flock (The Presage) vs. 5, James 4:10
 - a. Be Subject to the Elders (Especially younger believers)
 - b. Clothe Yourselves in Humility
 - i. God Opposes the Proud but Gives Grace to the Humble!
