Share Your Ministry Exodus 18:13-27

Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, advises him to divide and delegate duties to expedite decision making and improve governance. Jethro made it abundantly clear that overwork would wear out Moses as well as God's people.

Questions for Small Group Discussion:

- 1. In what ways does a leader's workload affect the rest of the church members?
- 2. What hinders some leaders from delegating more of the ministry duties to others?
- 3. How do the qualities of "able," "God-fearing," "trustworthy," and "hating bribes" still apply to good ministry leaders today?
- 4. Why do some church members resist stepping up to share the workload?
- 5. Have I ever seriously asked the Lord how He might want me to share the ministry giftings He has given to me with those who are already leading?
