  - a. How can you relate to any of the four soils?
  - b. What are some steps that you can take to prepare your heart to be fertile ground

for God's word?

- 3. Find a scripture or story in the Bible that describes each type of soil. Share some with the group.
  - a. The path/hard soil
  - b. Shallow/Rocky soil
  - c. Thorny soil
  - d. Good soil
- 4. Read Acts 8:18-24.
  - a. What kind of soil do you think best represents Simons heart?
  - b. How and why do you think Simon undervalued the kingdom?

c. Can you relate to any aspects of Simons approach to the kingdom? How so?

- 5. Reread the parable of the hidden treasure and the pearl in Matthew 13:44-46.
  - a. What makes the kingdom of God so valuable that it is worth all that you have?
  - b. Why is the man in verse 44 so joyful?
- 6. Your joy is connected to how valuable you find the treasure. Read Isaiah 12.

  - a. What can you be tempted to value most?
