1. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?

2. Why do you think we feel the need sometimes to put on a religious "mask"—to make it look like everything is okay and our character and sins aren't as bad as they appear? How can the truth represented in Romans 3:23-28 help us break out of that mindset and fight the temptation to cover things up or not let others know what's really going on in order to save face?

3. In light of Luke 23:32-43, how is it possible to see our ugly side (sins) and take responsibility for them yet not feel guilty or depressed? Share how you think the power of the cross can free us from pretense and worrying about what others think of us if they "really knew" who we are?

4. Read II Corinthians 5:11-21. Jesus paid the ultimate price for us to be free. How can the cross motivate you to live a transformed and resurrected life? Why is personal transformation of ourselves and others the goal, rather than simply "being nice" or helping others?

In light of the cross, let's let our walk with God be authentic. Let's let our relationships be deep, vulnerable and honest. Let's be free, so our light can shine in this lost world!
