Warm up (Avengers Assemble):

1. If the person to your left was a superhero (DC universe or Marvel), which one would they be and why?

(Age Of Ultron):

1. On Sunday we discussed how Isaacs faith in God's Endgame was on display when he planted his crop during times of severe drought. When things are not going as planned in your life, do you tend to: A) play conservative, watch how things play out or B) grind harder, take risks and try new things. What is your reasoning?

2. The recent events at Jax Church could be seen as times of spiritual drought. How has your outward faith been affected? Some examples of outward faith could be:

-Serving in ministries

-Attending spiritual groups

-Sharing your faith

-Initiating Godly discussions with other members

-Inviting people to church

-Looking for ways you can fill specific needs, etc.

Has it become more conservative, or been working harder? How might the following verses help us: Ephesians 4:1-16 & Galatians 6:9?

(Avengers Infinity War)

3. In Genesis 26:19 Isaac showed submission to the local herders for the sake of peace. This decision could have had drastic consequences on the survival of his family in a hot desert during a drought. His father Abraham had to fight another nation in order to save his family from danger (Gen 14). How can we distinguish between the right time to give up our “rights” to bless the nations and the right time to stand up and take action?

4. Everyone has a war battling within them. The war will determine if we will trust in God's will and desires for our life, or to acknowledge them but still do it our own way. What are you wrestling with right now that is difficult for you to trust in God's Plan? How might Mark 10:29 help.
