(Romans 2:1-4)

- 1. What usually motivates us to repent?
- 2. Why do you think God wants His Kindness to be what motivates us to repent?
- 3. Would you say His Kindness makes it easier for you to repent why or why not?

(Romans 12:1-2)

- 1. What usually motivates you to live a righteous life for God?
- 2. How often do you consciously think of ("in view") God's mercy driving you to do what you chose to do for Him?
- 3. Do you compartmentalize your Christianity or do you strive to "become like Christ" with your whole life?

(Luke 18:9-14)

Do you identify more with the Pharisee or the Tax Collector?
*If you identify with the Pharisee more, what are the challenges to seeing ourselves like the Tax Collector?

(Psalm 36:1-7)

- 1. Can you identify any ways that you can "flatter yourself too much to detect or hate your sin"?
- 2. How/Why do you think this hinders us from seeing God's love for each of us as "priceless" (v.7)?

(Titus 2:11-14)

- 1. How do you think God's grace is supposed to teach us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives?
- 2. How do you think this compares to relying on "structure" or "rules" to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives?
