- 3. Has there ever been a time when God didn't respond to your circumstances the way you wanted or expected? If so, what did that experience do to your faith?

- 4. During the message, Paul said the choice between God and science is a false alternative and that, "If everything were explained and explainable, it would not explain away God." Do you agree? Why or why not?
- 5. Do you tend to view God as one of the No Testament gods— the bodyguard god, on-demand god, boyfriend god, guilt god, anti-science god, gap god? If so, what would it take for you to begin to see him differently?
- 6. Read John 14:7–11. If you could know God by listening to Jesus and watching what he does, what are some of the big questions it might answer about who God is and what he thinks of people in general and you specifically?
- 7. Read Luke 11:2–4. Is it difficult for you to view God as a perfect father? Why or why not?
- 8. During the message, Paul said, "When it comes to God, Jesus is our most reliable source." What can you do this week to go directly to that source in order to connect with God and discover more about him? What can this group do to help and support you?
