Have you ever recovered from a "regression" (taking steps backward) in some aspect of your life? What did that look like and how did it feel?

Reflection and Discussion

1. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?

2. On Sunday, it was mentioned how hard it is for most of us to stay focused on one thing, no matter how good it is. Why can that type of sustained focus be so difficult? Is there anything that helps you do so?

3. If you could turn over one aspect of your life or situation to God for Him to control completely, but you still had to live with and navigate the consequences, which area would you be the most eager to do so?

Is there any area of your life where turning it over to God would be scariest? Why?

4. On Sunday, we talked about how Jesus is the "heir of all things". Read Luke 12:13-21. What concern do you think Jesus is trying to raise in his listeners (including us)? Sticking with the theme of "Better", what outcome do you think he was aiming for in our lives that would make our fate "better" than the character in the parable?

5. Challenge: Read (at least) Hebrews chapters 1-2 this week. Think, meditate, and pray about what you read. Take time to focus on Jesus and the ways he is "better" than competing priorities in your life. Ask Him to help you maintain focus on Him.
