## **Reflection and Discussion**

1. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?

- 2. One of the things God was careful to point out to the people that he called and formed in the Old Testament was that He did not call them into their special role because of their superiority or worthiness, and that they could expect to be held to a high standard of accountability (rather than excused) based on their special role. Read Deuteronomy 4:32-40, 7:7-12, and 9:4-6. Why do you think God was so careful to emphasize this point? How do you think it relates or applies to us today?
- 3. God was also very emphatic about how the Israelites were to treat foreigners among them. Read Leviticus 19:33-34, 23:22, 24:22, and Deuteronomy 10:18, 24:14-22). What do you think the heart behind these instructions is? What justification does God give the Israelites for how to treat "outsiders"? (Hint: Deut 24:22).
- 4. What do you think is the role of a Christian in the southern U.S. in living out God's vision of "gathering the nations" to himself and creating a house of prayer for all nations [people groups]? What is the role of a church in the southern U.S. to do the same? How can you personally help partner with God's intention and working towards this dream? How can your group or ministry do the same?
