Week 4

We use these times to *grow spiritually and to deepen our* relationships.

In this message series, we're focusing on how Jesus is "better"—better than any other pursuit or priority we could build our lives around. Right now, we're focusing on seven aspects in which Jesus is **better**.

Theme Passage: In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.—Hebrews 1:1-3

What is the most awe-inspiring moment you have every spent marveling at something beautiful or amazing in Creation?

Better.—Part II

Reflection and Discussion

1. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?

- 2. Read Psalm 8:1-9. Reflecting on your place in creation, how do you think God views you? How does that make you feel?
- 3. Read Psalm 19:1-4. In what ways do you think "the heavens declare the glory of God", as the psalmist says? Why do you think people over the world marvel at the sky (especially the night sky)?
- 4. Hebrews 1 is not the only passage in the Bible where it is taught that the universe was made through God the Son (Jesus). Read John 1:1-3 and Colossians 1:15-20. What stands out to you? Do you ever stop to consider that Jesus had and has an existence totally outside of his days of earthly life? How do you imagine the heavenly relationship has been enhanced by the fact that Jesus (the Son) has experienced both closeness (unity in purpose and love) with His Father and separation (notably on the cross and, in a sense, during Jesus' earthly life)?

When you enter God's family, you are entering a family eternally filled with love and closeness among Father, Son, and Spirit. Just as a child does not need to supply the love in a family she's born into, but grows to love her family because she is loved by them. Do you think meditating on God's love for you can cause your love for God and others to grow and flourish? Will you commit to that meditation this week?

5. How did it go with reading Hebrews 1-2 last week? Did anything strike your heart or mind? Will you read chapters 3-4 this week? Share things you read throughout the week with people in your group:)
