We use these times to grow spiritually and to deepen our relationships.

In this message series, we're focusing on how Jesus is "better"—better than any other pursuit or priority we could build our lives around. Right now, we're focusing on seven aspects in which Jesus is **better**.

Theme Passage: In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and **the exact representation of his being**, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.— Hebrews 1:1-3

a) Authority and power over everything

b) Completely unconcerned with our expectations of Him

c) Moved by our plight and Interested in our wellbeing

d) Utterly serious about holding us accountable for our response to opportunities He grants us

e) Totally committed to loving us and acting in our best interests

3. On Sunday, the questions were asked, "Are you building your life around Jesus? Are your pursuing him and prioritizing his priorities?" If you have been moved, challenged, or convicted to re-assign value and re-align anything in your viewpoint or everyday actions, would you share it with the group?

4. Reflect on the fifth of the seven phrases in our theme passage: "**sustaining all things by his powerful word**". What do you think that means? What implication does it have for your outlook and life?
