1. At the beginning of the story of Gideon we find the Israelites in a really bad place, struggling to survive by hiding from the Midianites in caves. When is the last time you were in “spiritual survivor mode?” What was that like? How hard was it to stay positive?
2. Share a personal story of a time when you knew what God wanted you to do but had a hard time following through? Remember the story of Gideon and the fleece.
3. In Judges 7 we see God reduce the number of fighting men from over 30,000 to just 300. What do you tend to put your trust and security in when it isn't God?

4. Why is it hard to simply say “yes” when God calls us to do something?

5. Of the three things that hold most of us back (fear, doubt, and insecurity), which one do you struggle with the most? Why?

6. When is the last time you told God exactly how you felt, even if it wasn't super spiritual? How did you feel afterwards?

7. Where do you think God is calling you at this point in your life? What will it take for you to follow him there with all your heart?
