

I) Jesus Redeemed Us from Poverty to a Blessed Prosperous Life

A) Psalm 107:1-2 – Redeem (heb) – purchase, deliver, to buy back a relative’s property

v.2 – Jesus provides full redemption from satan’s dominion to men.

B) Galatians 3:13-14,29 (AMPC) – Jesus redeemed us from all the curse of the law. Now the full blessing of Abraham can come on all the redeemed by faith.

C) Galatians 3:13 – Poverty is a curse not a blessing.

1) Genesis 3:17-19 – Poverty came on man because of his sin. Poverty and struggle to make ends meet is a curse.

2) Deuteronomy 28:15-19,38,45-46 – Poverty is a curse for sin and breaking God’s laws.

v.46 – Poverty is passed on to the next generation.

D) Galatians 3:13-14 – Jesus redeemed us from poverty and lack into the blessing of God’s provision and abundance.

1) II Corinthians 8:9 – Jesus took our curse of poverty so we could walk in prosperity and success.

v.9 (AMPC) – Rich (grk) – to become wealthy, be increased with goods. (Become enriched, Abundantly supplied)

E) Galatians 3:29 – We are now heirs to Abraham’s blessings.

1) Genesis 13:2 – (very rich in cattle, silver, gold) (AMPC) – Extremely rich.

F) Philippians 4:19 – We are now to make God our source of supply.

We look to God to abundantly supply all our needs and to bless us with provision.

G) 3 Things We Must Do to Walk in the Blessing of Prosperity

1) III John 2 – We must renew our mind with God’s promises and break the poverty mentality. Change how you think and believe to line up with God’s Word.

2) Matthew 6:31-32 (v.33) – Seek first God’s Kingdom; God’s laws and ways of doing things. If you want to prosper, take time to learn how to follow the Lord, do things His way.

3) Deuteronomy 28:1-2 – This still works – Be led by God’s Spirit and be a doer of His Word and ALL these blessings will come on you and overtake you.
