

Kingdom Laws of Increase

Text: Colossians 1:12-14 (AMPC) – God has brought us into Covenant Relationship and has positioned us to partake of our Inheritance in Christ Jesus.

I) God's Kingdom Works in Partnership with Us and God

A) Mark 4:11, 26-29 (v.11) – It is God's will for us to know how to partake of our Kingdom Inheritance.

v.26 – The Kingdom of God responds to our seed actions of faith. We activate the Kingdom of God to produce our provision by our act of faith and obedience to God's Word.

vv.27-29 – God turns our seed of obedience into a harvest of blessing.

B) Two Spiritual Laws that Govern Seedtime and Harvest

#1) Galatians 6:7-8 – You always reap of the same kind of seed you sow.

#2) Luke 6:38 – You always reap more than you sow.

II) Four Keys to Sowing and Reaping

#1) Make God Your Source – Know the difference between source and resource.

a) Deuteronomy 8:18 – Remember it is God who gives you power to get wealth.

b) Philippians 4:19 - God supplies our need. He may use many resources but He is your source.

c) Proverbs 3:5-6 – You will not make God your source until you trust Him.

vv.5-6 (AMPC) – Trust – be confident, secure, sure

d) Hebrews 11:6 – You must have faith that God will bless you and meet your need.

#2) You Must Sow Your Seed First – You must act in faith.

a) Mark 11:22-23 – 1st – Faith in God, 2nd – Faith released into the problem.

b) II Corinthians 9:6-7 – Kingdom responds to faith. Purpose in your heart, sow your seed.

#3) Expect A Miracle – Trust God to Do His Part

a) II Corinthians 9:7-8 – Believe God to bring forth your provision and harvest of blessing.

b) Hebrews 6:10-12 – Be Patient – Let God work for you. You don't have to understand it, you just have to believe it.

#4) Confess and Receive Your Harvest by Faith

a) Hebrews 4:14 – claim it, confess it, receive it.

b) Mark 11:24 – You must believe you receive and then you will have it.
